Notice of Petition for Forfeiture and Summons by Publication

The Tulalip Tribes Office of Reservation Attorney gives notice that the property listed below was seized for forfeiture for violation of Tribal Law. Laws and procedures applicable to the forfeiture process can be found in Tulalip Tribal Code (TTC) Chapters 2.10 and 2.60. TO FILE A CLAIM: If you are an owner or claimant, you may contest the forfeiture of the property listed below by filing an answer with the Tribal Court no later than 30 days after the date of final publication of this notice. You must serve a copy of your answer on the Tribal Prosecutor. You may request a copy of the summons, petition, and evidence in your case from the Tribal Prosecutor.

YOU ARE HEREBY NOTIFIED that the Tulalip Tribes, Plaintiff, by and through its prosecuting authority, has filed a petition with the Court that seeks to have forfeited, to the benefit of the Tribes, certain property that you allegedly own, claim, or have an interest.

Pursuant to Chapter 2.60.070§(4)(a), of the Tulalip Tribes Code of Law, you have thirty (30) days after you have been served the petition and this summons to file with the Court a response to the allegations described in the petition. No extension of the time for filing the response may be granted. Failure to respond within 30 days may bar you from presenting evidence at any later evidentiary hearing regarding the seized property. Further, if no response is filed within 30 days after service of the petition and summons, the Court, upon motion of the Tribes, shall order the property forfeited to the Tribes.

Chapter 2.60.070§(4)(b) governs responses to forfeiture petitions. The Clerk's Office does not provide legal advice. It is your responsibility to familiarize yourself with the applicable tribal law—which is available from the Clerk's Office and on-line at: <http://www.codepublishing.com/WA/Tulalip/>

10 COMES NOW the Tulalip Tribes, Plaintiff, by and through its prosecuting authority, to
11 petition the Court to institute proceedings for the forfeiture of the property described in section
12 I, below. The Court has subject matter jurisdiction over these proceedings, and this Petition is
13 made pursuant to, Chapter 2.60 of the Tulalip Tribes Code of Law.

14 **I. SUBJECT PROPERTY**

15 As described in detail in Tulalip Police Incident Report #20-1070, which is on file with
16 the Tulalip Tribal Court under this cause number, on or about the 7th day of May, 2020, Tulalip
17 Tribal Police (TPD) seized a 2011 GMC Terrain & VIN #2CTFLXE55B6252307 from Tara
18 Kimball (driver) and Jason Zimmerman (registered/legal owner) in the vicinity of 88th Street off-
19 ramp, Tulalip, Washington in connection with narcotics trafficking on the Tulalip Reservation.

20 **II. AUTHORITY**

21 Because the Subject Vehicle was used or was intended to be used to facilitate the
22 transportation, sale, receipt, possession, or concealment of a controlled substance, listed
23 chemical, or proceeds from the sale of a controlled substance in violation of Tulalip Law, it is
24 subject to forfeiture pursuant to Tulalip Tribal Code 2.60.020§(5).

III. CLAIMANTS

Tara Kimball, driver, from whom the subject property was seized, the registered/legal owner of the vehicle, Jason Zimmerman, are the only people who the Tribes knows or has reason to believe has or may asset a claim to the subject property. Tara Kimball is believed to reside at 2208 18th Street, Everett, Washington 98201 (Police Report) and Jason Zimmerman is believed to reside at 32720 124th Street SE, Sultan, Washington 98294 (Police Report).

IV. CONCLUSION

Based upon the foregoing, the Tribes requests the Clerk of the Court issue a Summons to have Tara Kimball and Jason Zimmerman answer the allegations of this Petition, and, ultimately, for the Court to order that the Subject Property be forfeited for the benefit of the Tulalip Tribes.
