The Court has subject matter jurisdiction over these proceedings, and this Petition is made pursuant to, Chapter 2.60 of the Tulalip Tribes Code of Law.

I. SUBJECT PROPERTY

As described in detail in Tulalip Police Incident Report #21-0896, which is on file with the Tulalip Tribal Court under this cause number, on or about the 9th day of April, 2021, Tulalip Tribal Police (TPD) seized a \$2,010 from Ryan Seward-Arestad and Marina Lebedev in the vicinity of [ADDRESS WHERE PROPERTY IS SIEZED], Tulalip, Washington in connection with narcotics trafficking on the Tulalip Reservation.

II. AUTHORITY

Because the Subject Money was furnished or intended to be furnished by any person in exchange for a controlled substance or listed chemical in violation of Tulalip Law, it is subject to forfeiture pursuant to Tulalip Tribal Code 2.60.020§(7).

1	III. CLAIMANTS
2	Ryan Seward-Arestad and Marina Lebedev, from whom the subject property was seized
3	are the only people who the Tribes knows or has reason to believe has or may assert a claim to
4	the subject property. Ryan Seward-Arestad is believed to be residing at 1182 East Axton Road
5	Bellingham, Washington 98226 (Police Report). Ryan Seward-Arestad is housed at the
6	Snohomish County Jail located at 3025 Oakes Avenue, Everett, Washington 98201. Marina
7	Lebedev is believed to be residing at 6199 Silver Spruce Way, Maple Falls, Washington 98266
8	(Police Report).
9	IV. CONCLUSION
10	Based upon the foregoing, the Tribes requests the Clerk of the Court issue a Summons
11	to have Ryan Seward-Arestad and Marina Lebedev answer the allegations of this Petition, and
12	ultimately, for the Court to order that the Subject Property be forfeited for the benefit of the
13	Tulalip Tribes.
