PETITION FOR FORFEITURE OF SEIZED PROPERTY

COMES NOW the Tulalip Tribes, Plaintiff, by and through its prosecuting authority, to petition the Court to institute proceedings for the forfeiture of the property described in section I, below. The Court has subject matter jurisdiction over these proceedings, and this Petition is made pursuant to, Chapter 2.60 of the Tulalip Tribes Code of Law.

I. Subject Property

As described in detail in Tulalip Tribes Police Department Incident Report #23-3648, which is on file with the Tulalip Tribal Court under this cause number, on or about the 13th day of November, 2023, Tulalip Tribes Police Department (TTPD) seized a 2015 BMW 328 Vin #WBA3C1C5XFK124658 from Gregory Bjorn (driver/registered owner) and Flagship Credit Acceptance (legal owner) in the vicinity of 6221 31st Avenue NE Tulalip, WA 98271 in connection with narcotic trafficking on the Tulalip Reservation.

II. AUTHORITY

Because the Subject Vehicle was used or was intended to be used to facilitate the transportation, sale, receipt, possession, or concealment of a controlled substance, listed chemical, or proceeds from the sale of a controlled substance in violation of Tulalip Law, it is subject to forfeiture pursuant to Tulalip Tribal Code 2.60.020§(5).

III. Claimants

Gregory Bjorn is a person who the Tribes knows or has reason to believe has or may asset a claim to the subject property. IV. CONCLUSION

Based upon the foregoing, the Tribes requests the Clerk of the Court issue a Summons to have Gregory Bjorn and Flagship Credit Acceptance answer the allegations of this Petition, and, ultimately, for the Court to order that the Subject Property be forfeited for the benefit of the Tulalip Tribes.
