The Tulalip Tribes Office of Reservation Attorney gives notice that the property listed below was seized for forfeiture for violation of Tribal Law. You must serve a copy of your answer on the Tribal Prosecutor. You may request a copy of the summons, petition, and evidence in your case from the Tribal Prosecutor.

YOU ARE HEREBY NOTIFIED that the Tulalip Tribes, Plaintiff, by and through its prosecuting authority, has filed a petition with the Court that seeks to have forfeited, to the benefit of the Tribes, certain property that you allegedly own, claim, or have an interest.

Pursuant to Chapter 2.60.070§(4)(a), of the Tulalip Tribes Code of Law, you have thirty (30) days after you have been served the petition and this summons to file with the Court a response to the allegations described in the petition. No extension of the time for filing the response may be granted. Failure to respond within 30 days may bar you from presenting evidence at any later evidentiary hearing regarding the seized property. Further, if no response is filed within 30 days after service of the petition and summons, the Court, upon motion of the Tribes, shall order the property forfeited to the Tribes.

Chapter 2.60.070§(4)(b) governs responses to forfeiture petitions. The Clerk's Office does not provide legal advice. It is your responsibility to familiarize yourself with the applicable tribal law—which is available from the Clerk's Office and on-line at:

PETITION FOR FORFEITURE OF

COMES NOW the Tulalip Tribes, Plaintiff, by and through its prosecuting authority, to petition the Court to institute proceedings for the forfeiture of the property described in section I, below. The Court has subject matter jurisdiction over these proceedings, and this Petition is made pursuant to, Chapter 2.60 of the Tulalip Tribes Code of Law.

I. Subject Property

As described in detail in Tulalip Tribes Police Department Incident Report #24-3547, which is on file with the Tulalip Tribal Court under this cause number, on or about the December 10, 2025, Tulalip Tribes Police Department (TTPD) seized a 2015 Nissan Rogue from Carlos Gutama Escandon (driver/legal owner) in the vicinity of 6323 33rd Avenue NE Tulalip, WA 98271 in connection with narcotic trafficking on the Tulalip Reservation.

II. AUTHORITY

Because the Subject Vehicle was used or was intended to be used to facilitate the transportation, sale, receipt, possession, or concealment of a controlled substance, listed chemical, or proceeds from the sale of a controlled substance in violation of Tulalip Law, it is subject to forfeiture pursuant to Tulalip Tribal Code 2.60.020§(5).

1 **III. Claimants**


2 CarlosGutama Escandon is a person who the Tribes knows or has reason to believe has
3 or may asset a claim to the subject property. CarlosGutama Escandon is believed to reside at
4 11311 SE 162nd Street, Renton, Washington 98055.

5 **IV. CONCLUSION**

6 Based upon the foregoing, the Tribes requests the Clerk of the Court issue a Summons
7 to have CarlosGutama Escandon answer the allegations of this Petition, and, ultimately, for the
8 Court to order that the Subject Property be forfeited for the benefit of the Tulalip Tribes.
