COMES NOW the Tulalip Tribes, Plaintiff, by and through its prosecuting authority, to petition the Court to institute proceedings for the forfeiture of the property described in section I, below. The Court has subject matter jurisdiction over these proceedings, and this Petition is made pursuant to, Chapter 2.60 of the Tulalip Tribes Code of Law.

#### SUBJECT PROPERTY

As described in detail in Tulalip Police Incident Report #21-0803, which is on file with the Tulalip Tribal Court under this cause number, on or about the 31st day of March, 2021 Tulalip Tribal Police (TPD) seized a 2006 Chrysler 300 & VIN #2C3KA53G66H258639 from Gonzalo Cortez Abarca (driver/legal owner) in the vicinity of 6221 31st Avenue NE, Tulalip, Washington in connection with narcotics trafficking on the Tulalip Reservation.

#### II. AUTHORITY

Because the Subject Vehicle was used or was intended to be used to facilitate the transportation, sale, receipt, possession, or concealment of a controlled substance, listed chemical, or proceeds from the sale of a controlled substance in violation of Tulalip Law, it is subject to forfeiture pursuant to Tulalip Tribal Code 2.60.020§(5).

1	III. CLAIMANTS
2	Gonzalo Cortez Abarca, driver/legal owner, from whom the subject property was seized,
3	is the only person who the Tribes knows or has reason to believe has or may asset a claim to the
4	subject property. Gonzalo Cortez Abarca is believed to reside at 724 2 <sup>nd</sup> Avenue S., Kent,
5	Washington 98064 (Police Report).
6	IV. CONCLUSION
7	Based upon the foregoing, the Tribes requests the Clerk of the Court issue a Summons
8	to have 2006 Chrysler 300 & VIN #2C3KA53G66H258639 answer the allegations of this
9	Petition, and, ultimately, for the Court to order that the Subject Property be forfeited for the
10	benefit of the Tulalip Tribes.
