COMES NOW the Tulalip Tribes, Plaintiff, by and through its prosecuting authority, to petition the Court to institute proceedings for the forfeiture of the property described in section I, below. The Court has subject matter jurisdiction over these proceedings, and this Petition is made pursuant to, Chapter 2.60 of the Tulalip Tribes Code of Law.

1. SUBJECT PROPERTY

As described in detail in Tulalip Police Incident Report #20-2290, which is on file with the Tulalip Tribal Court under this cause number, on or about the 16th day of September, 2020, Tulalip Tribal Police (TPD) seized a \$8,755 from Justice Peele in the vicinity of 6410 33rd Avenue NE, Tulalip, Washington in connection with narcotics trafficking on the Tulalip Reservation.

II. AUTHORITY

Because the Subject Money was furnished or intended to be furnished by any person in exchange for a controlled substance or listed chemical in violation of Tulalip Law, it is subject to forfeiture pursuant to Tulalip Tribal Code 2.60.020§(7).

1	III. CLAIMANTS
2	Justice Peele, from whom the subject property was seized, is the only person who the
3	Tribes knows or has reason to believe has or may assert a claim to the subject property. Justice
4	Peele is currently housed at the Snohomish County Jail, located at 3025 Oakes Avenue, Everett,
5	Washington 98201 (Jail Registry).
6	IV. CONCLUSION
7	Based upon the foregoing, the Tribes requests the Clerk of the Court issue a Summons
8	to have Justice Peelc answer the allegations of this Petition, and, ultimately, for the Court to
9	order that the Subject Property be forfeited for the benefit of the Tulalip Tribes.
